AMENDED CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to an election conducted by the Fraternal Order of Police, Local #1, on December 27, 1996, a majority of the employees of the City of East Providence, Police Department, voted to affiliate/merge with the International Brotherhood of Police Officers, and to designate the International Brotherhood of Police Officers as their collective bargaining representative.

Further, a majority vote of the bargaining unit was taken on September 9, 1998, to amend the Certification of Representatives to delete any and all references to Lodge #1, Fraternal Order of Police.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board, by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the International Brotherhood of Police Officers has been designated and selected by a majority of all full time permanent police officers of the City of East Providence as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the International Brotherhood of Police Officers is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
