AMENDED CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to the counting of ballots by the South County Lodge #12, F.O.P., on April 26, 1995, a majority of the employees of the Town of South Kingstown Police Department voted to affiliate/merge with the International Brotherhood of Police Officer, and to designate the International Brotherhood of Police Officers as their collective bargaining representative.

Further, based on a majority vote of the bargaining unit taken on December 14, 1996, the South County Lodge #12, F.O.P. ceased to exist

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board, by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the International Brotherhood of Police Officers has been designated and selected by a majority of all members of the South Kingstown Police Department from rank of patrolman up to and including Chief as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the International Brotherhood of Police Officers is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
