CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the Town of Coventry and the International Brotherhood of Police Officers, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election Thursday, November 3, 1966, by Comparison of Signatures of: Chief to Patrolmen inclusive.

On the basis of the Comparison of Signatures of said employees as aforesaid, the International Brotherhood of Police Officers, has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Town of Coventry, as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the International Brotherhood of Police Officers has been designated and selected by a majority of: Chief to Patrolmen inclusive of the Town of Coventry, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, International Brotherhood of Police Officers, is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
