Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the City of Cranston and the Cranston Highway Employees Association, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on November 17, 1966, by Comparison of Signatures of: All employees of the recreation department, excepting the Director.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Cranston Highway Employees Association has been designated and selected by a majority of: All Employees of the recreation department, excepting the Director, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, Cranston Highway Employees Association, is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
