has been designated by a majority of said employees of State of Rhode Island -- Blackstone Valley Sewer District Commission as their bargaining representative.


The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 6, of the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Act, Chapter 1066 of the Public Laws of 1941, as amended, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the R. I. Public Employees, Council 70, AFSCME, AFL-CIO has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the Blackstone Valley Sewer District Commission, excluding the Commissioners, the Executive Secretary, Senior Accountant, accountants, Chemical Engineer, Maintenance Engineer, Administrative Assistant and supervisors

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 6, subdivision 1, of the Act, the R. I. Public Employees, Council 70, AFSCME, AFL-CIO

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
