CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between State of Rhode Island Department of Labor and Rhode Island State Employees Association and Rhode Island Public Employees Council 70 AFSCME AFL-CIO the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on June 29, 1967

by secret ballot of all departmental employees excluding Director, Deputy Director, Administrative Assistant to Director, Confidential Secretary to Director, Executive Secretary, Assistant Executive Secretary to the State Labor Relations Board and Conciliators and Doctors employed by the Rhode Island State Curative Center, Executive Assistant to Curative Center and Division Chiefs

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, the Rhode Island State Employees Association has been designated by a majority of said employees of State of Rhode Island - Department of Labor as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Rhode Island State Employees Association

has been designated and selected by a majority of the departmental employees excluding Director, Deputy Director, Administrative Assistant to Director, Confidential Secretary to Director, Executive Secretary, Assistant Executive Secretary to the State Labor Relations Board and Conciliators and Doctors employed by the Rhode Island State Curative Center, Executive Assistant to Curative Center and Division Chiefs

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the Rhode Island State Employees Association

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
