CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between The Housing Authority of the City of Providence, R. I. and Laborers International Union of North America, AFL-CIO the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on October 31, 1967

by secret ballot of all Housing Authority Employees, employed at Chad Brown, Valley View, Manton Heights, Roger Williams, Dextor Manor, Hartford Park, Bradford House, and Coddington Court, excluding Office Clerical Employees, Painter, Plasterers, Carpenters, Electricians, Bricklayers, and Supts. of said Housing Projects

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, the Laborers International Union of North America, AFL-CIO

has been designated by a majority of said employees of The Housing Authority of the City of Providence, Rhode Island as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Laborers International Union of North America, AFL-CIO has been designated and selected by a majority of the Housing Authority Employees, employed at Chad Brown, Valley View, Manton Heights, Roger Williams, Dextor Manor, Hartford Park, Bradford House, and Coddington Court, excluding Office Clerical Employees, Painter, Plasterers, Carpenters, Electricians, Bricklayers, and Supts. of said Housing Projects

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the Laborers International Union of North America, AFL-CIO

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
