The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Howard Union of Teachers, Local 1171, AFT, AFL-CIO has been designated and selected by a majority of: Unclassified, certified teachers in the Division of Instructional Services, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, Howard Union of Teachers, Local 1171, AFT, AFL-CIO, is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
