CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the Town of Jamestown (all permanent regular police officers employed by the Jamestown Police Department from the rank of patrolman up to and including the Chief) and Local 1, I.B.P.O., the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on June 19, 1969, by Comparison of Signatures of: All permanent regular police officers employed by the Jamestown Police Department from the rank of patrolman up to and including the Chief.

On the basis of the Comparison of Signatures of said employees as aforesaid, Local 1, I.B.P.O., has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Town of Jamestown (all permanent regular police officers employed by the Jamestown Police Department from the rank of patrolman up to and including the Chief), as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that Local 1, I.B.P.O. has been designated and selected by a majority of: All permanent regular police officers employed by the Jamestown Police Department from the rank of patrolman up to and including the Chief of the Town of Jamestown, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, Local 1, I.B.P.O. is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
