CERTIFIED, that the International Brotherhood of Police Officers, Local #1 has been designated and selected by a majority of: All uniformed police officers employed by the Town of Narragansett up to and including the Chief, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, International Brotherhood of Police Officers, Local #1 is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
