CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the Town of Johnston - Fire Department (all permanent fire fighters excluding the Chief of the Department) and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1950, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on October 7, 1970, by Comparison of Signatures of: All permanent fire fighters excluding the Chief of the Department.

On the basis of the Comparison of Signatures of said employees as aforesaid, the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1950, has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Town of Johnston - Fire Department (all permanent fire fighters excluding the Chief of the Department), as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1950 has been designated and selected by a majority of: All permanent fire fighters excluding the Chief of the Department, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1950 is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
