CERTIFIED, that the Public Service Employees has been designated and selected by a majority of: All Staff Representatives and Secretaries excluding Executive Director, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, Public Service Employees is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
