CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between Town of Lincoln School Department and Council 70, American Federation State, County & Municipal Employees AFL-CIO the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on November 15, 1971

by secret ballot of All Employees of the School Department including but not limited to Clerks, Janitors, Custodians, Bus Drivers, Secretaries, Matrons, Maintenance Mechanics, Teacher Aides, Library Clerks and excluding Supervisors, Technical Aides and Certified Teaching Personnel.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, the Council 70, American Federation State, County and Municipal Employees AFL-CIO

has been designated by a majority of said employees of Town of Lincoln School Department as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Council 70, American Federation State, County & Municipal Employees AFL-CIO has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the school department including but not limited to Clerks, Janitors, Custodians, Bus Drivers, Secretaries, Matrons, Maintenance Mechanics, Teacher Aides, Library Clerks and excluding Supervisors, Technical Aides and Certified Teaching Personnel.

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the Council 70, American Federation State, County and Municipal Employees AFL-CIO

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
