CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between Adult Correctional Institutions, Dept. of Social & Rehabilitative Services, State of R. I. and R. I. Brotherhood of Correctional Officers and R. I. Public Employees, Council 70, AFSCME, AFL-CIO the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on March 17, 1972

by secret ballot of all employees of the Adult Correctional Institutions excluding employees of Probation and Parole and Parole Board; Professional Employees; Supervisory Employees; and Registered Nurses.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, the R. I. Brotherhood of Correctional Officers

has been designated by a majority of said employees of Adult Correctional Institutions, Dept. of Social & Rehabilitative Services, State of Rhode Island, as their bargaining representative.


The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the R. I. Brotherhood of Correctional Officers has been designated and selected by a majority of the all employees of the Adult Correctional Institutions excluding employees of Probation and Parole and Parole Board; Professional Employees; Supervisory Employees; and Registered Nurses.

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the R. I. Brotherhood of Correctional Officers

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
