CERTIFIED, that the International Brotherhood of Police Officers (NAGE) has been designated and selected by a majority of ~~the~~ All full-time policemen employed by the Town of North Kingstown excluding the Chief

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the International Brotherhood of Police Officers (NAGE)

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
