as their bargaining representative.


The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said

Zambarano Memorial Hospital, excluding Clinical Director


as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of
