CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the Town of Lincoln, Water Department (all full-time employees of the Town of Lincoln Water Department, excluding office and clerical and management personnel) and the Rhode Island General Council of L.I.U.N.A. on behalf of Local Union 1033, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on April 26, 1974 by Comparison of Signatures of: All full-time employees of the Town of Lincoln, Water Department, excluding office and clerical and management personnel.

On the basis of the Comparison of Signatures of said employees as aforesaid, the Rhode Island General Council of L.I.U.N.A. on behalf of Local Union 1033 has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Town of Lincoln, Water Department (all full-time employees of the Town of Lincoln, Water Department, excluding office and clerical and management personnel), as their collective bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Rhode Island General Council of L.I.U.N.A. on behalf of Local Union 1033 has been designated and selected by a majority of: All full-time employees of the Town of Lincoln, Water Department, excluding office and clerical and management personnel, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, Rhode Island General Council of L.I.U.N.A. on behalf of Local Union 1033 is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
