Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between East Greenwich Police Department and International Brotherhood of Police Officers (NAGE) the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on February 14, 1975 by secret ballot of all employees of the East Greenwich Police Department other than permanent Police Officers

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, the International Brotherhood of Police Officers (NAGE) has been designated by a majority of said employees of East Greenwich Police Department as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the International Brotherhood of Police Officers (NAGE) has been designated and selected by a majority of ~~the~~ all employees of the East Greenwich Police Department other than permanent Police Officers

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16, (1) of the Act, the International Brotherhood of Police Officers (NAGE)

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
