AMENDED CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the **Town of Bristol – Town Hall** and **United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union (USW)**, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on September 2, 1975, by secret ballot of: All Clerks and Secretaries employed at the Town Hall, 10 Court Street, Bristol, Rhode Island; excluding Clerks and Secretaries employed by the Police Department.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, **United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union (USW)** has been designated by a majority of said employees of the **Town of Bristol – Town Hall** as their bargaining representative.

That on February 25, 2020, a request was received from United Steelworkers of America (**United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union (USW)**) that the above-entitled certification be amended to reflect the identity change of the party's representatives.

That on March 12, 2020, after review and discussion, the RI State Labor Relations Board accepted the request for amendment to this certification, reflecting the identity change of the party's representatives, to read: **Town of Bristol – Town Hall and United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union (USW)**.

THEREFORE, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that **United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union (USW)** has been designated and selected by a majority of: All Clerks and Secretaries employed at the Town Hall, 10 Court Street, Bristol, Rhode Island; excluding Clerks and Secretaries employed by the Police Department, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining; and that pursuant to the provisions of §28-7-16 of the Act, **United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union (USW)** is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
