CERTIFIED, that RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 911 has been designated and selected by a majority of: All City employees, excluding supervisory and professional personnel, as described in Certification EE-1764, as well as excluding policemen, firemen, teachers and employees as defined in Certification EE-1727, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining; and that pursuant to the provisions of §28-7-16 of the Act, RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 911 is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
