AMENDED CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a vote of the membership taken on August 1, 2000, a majority of the employees of the Town of Johnston School Department included in the bargaining unit defined in Case No. EE-3368 and represented by the Independent Association of Employees voted to merge with the Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local Union 808.

Further, a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit have signed dues deduction authorization cards to have the Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local Union 808 as their sole and exclusive bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board, by virtue of an pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, of the General of Laws of Rhode Island, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local Union 808 has been designated and selected by a majority of all non-certified personnel including: Clerks, Custodians, Bus Drivers, Mechanics, Maintenance, Teacher Aides, Matrons, Crossing Guard; excluding Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds, and Secretary to the School Committee, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16 of the Act, the Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local Union 808 is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
