CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES


Pursuant to a Recognition Agreement by and between the Providence School Board (all employees employed as full-time bus monitors excluding all other employees and specifically excluding employees employed as part-time bus monitors. This certification is to be deemed consistent with the attached recognition agreement entered into between the parties.), and the Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local Union 1033, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on December 19, 1986, by signature card comparison of: all employees employed as full-time bus monitors excluding all other employees and specifically excluding employees employed as part-time bus monitors, employed by the Providence School Board.



The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of an pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled "State Labor Relations Act", it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local Union 1033 has been designated and selected by a majority of: all employees employed as full-time bus monitors excluding all other employees and specifically excluding employees employed as part-time bus monitors, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, the Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local Union 1033 is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
