Pursuant to an Ordered Election by and between the State of R.I., Dept of Corrections and Dept of Children & Their Families Probation and Parole -AND- R.I. Probation and Parole Association, National Education Assoc of RI/NEA and R.I. Laborers' District Council on behalf of the R.I. Judicial, Professional and Technical Employees' Local Union 808, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on November 29, 1989

by secret ballot of all professional employees in Probation and Parole excluding supervisors, Parole Board members and clerical employees, including Community Service Coordinators, in accordance with EE-1955, and all amendments thereto.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, the R.I. Probation and Parole Association has been designated by a majority of said employees of the State of Rhode Island, Dept of Corrections and Dept of Children & Their Families Probation and Parole as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 6, of the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Act, Chapter 1066 of the Public Laws of 1941, as amended, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the R.I. Probation and Parole Association has been designated and selected by a majority of the all professional employees in Probation and Parole excluding supervisors, Parole Board members and clerical employees, including Community Service Coordinators, in accordance with EE-1955, and all amendments thereto.

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 6, subdivision 1, of the Act, the R.I. Probation and Parole Association

is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
