CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to an Ordered Election by and between the Bristol/Warren Regional School District, National Education Association of Rhode Island and Rhode Island Council 94, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on February 18, 1994

by secret ballot of all non-certified employees of the Bristol/Warren Regional School District including but not limited to: School Aides, Clerks, Custodians, Secretaries, Teacher Aides, Matrons, Janitors, Maintenance, Truck Driver, Library Aides, Payroll Clerk, Senior Custodian.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, Rhode Island Council 94, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees

has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Bristol/Warren Regional School District as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 6, of the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Act, Chapter 1066 of the Public Laws of 1941, as amended, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that Rhode Island Council 94, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees has been designated and selected by a majority of all non-certified employees of the Bristol/Warren Regional School District including but not limited to: School Aides, Clerks, Custodians, Secretaries, Teacher Aides, Matrons, Janitors, Maintenance, Truck Driver Library Aides, Payroll Clerk, Senior Custodian

as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 6, subdivision 1, of the Act, Rhode Island Council 94, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
