CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to a Consent Agreement by and between the Rhode Island Board of Regents for Elementary and Secondary Education and the Rhode Island School for the Deaf Teachers Association/NEA, the Rhode Island School for the Deaf Teachers Association/NEA has been designated as the collective bargaining representative of all permanent full-time certified teachers at the Rhode Island School for the Deaf, which include academic teachers, guidance counselors, school psychologists, and excluding all others.

By virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board under Section 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Rhode Island School for the Deaf Teachers Association/NEA has been designated by consent agreement as the sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining of all permanent full-time certified teachers, which include academic teachers, guidance counselors, school psychologists, and excluding all others employed at the Rhode Island School for the Deaf and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16, of the Act, the Rhode Island School for the Deaf Teachers Association/NEA is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
