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**AMENDED CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES**

Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the Central Falls Housing Authority and Teamsters Local 64, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on Monday, March 25, 2002, by secret ballot of: all non-supervisory employees, employed by the Central Falls Housing Authority.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, Teamsters Local 64 had been designated by a majority of said employees of the Central Falls Housing Authority as their bargaining representative.

On December 30, 2005 the RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO filed a Consent Agreement and Affidavit, as well as all the appropriate documentation for the Transfer of Bargaining Units between National Organizations - Change of Jurisdiction with the RI State Labor Relations Board. In accordance with the RI State Labor Relations Board's Rules and Regulations, Section 8.10, Transfer of Bargaining Units between National Organizations - Change of Jurisdiction, the members of the Central Falls Housing Authority petitioned the Board for change in jurisdiction; resulting in the transfer of the following positions into RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO: **Public Housing Coordinators; Maintenance Laborers; Mod and Systems Coordinator; Administration Clerk; Public Housing; Lease Housing Assistants; Inspector; and Maintenance Manager.**

On February 28, 2006, after review and discussion of all documentation submitted, the RI State Labor Relations Board voted to accept the Transfer of Bargaining Units between National Organizations - Change of Jurisdiction; recognizing RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO as the exclusive bargaining representative for those employees listed above.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that **RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO** has been designated and selected by a majority of: all **Public Housing Coordinators; Maintenance Laborers; Mod and Systems Coordinator; Administration Clerk; Public Housing; Lease Housing Assistants; Inspector; and Maintenance Manager;** as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16 of the Act, the RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
