CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES


Pursuant to a Directed Order of Election by and between the Marion J. Mohr Memorial Library and the United Service and Allied Workers of Rhode Island (USAW), the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on Thursday, June 8, 2006, by secret ballot of: Professional Librarians including Reference Librarian, Young Adult Librarian and Children's Librarian; excluding all other current full time employees and those excluded according to the law, as of May 10, 2006.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, United Service and Allied Workers of Rhode Island (USAW), has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Marion J. Mohr Memorial Library, as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the United Service and Allied Workers of Rhode Island (USAW) has been designated and selected by a majority of: the Professional Librarians including Reference Librarian, Young Adult Librarian and Children's Librarian; excluding all other current full time employees and those excluded according to the law, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining; and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16 of the Act, the United Service and Allied Workers of Rhode Island (USAW) is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.




