Pursuant to an Agreement for Consent Election by Comparison of Signatures by and between the Town of Scituate and National Association of Government Employees (NAGE), the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an Election by Comparison of Signatures on May 27, 2014.



The parties have stipulated and agreed that the following positions share a community of interest and fall within the Municipal Employees' Arbitration Act and, therefore, shall be included in the bargaining unit defined as: All full-time police dispatchers in the Scituate Police Department.

On the basis of the Comparison of Signatures of said employees as aforesaid, the National Association of Government Employees (NAGE) has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Town of Scituate as their collective bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by Section 28-7-16, of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby:

**CERTIFIED**, that the National Association of Government Employees (NAGE) has been designated and selected by a majority of: All full-time police dispatchers in the Scituate Police Department as their sole representative for the purposes of collective bargaining; and that pursuant to the provisions of Section 28-7-16 of the Act, the National Association of Government Employees (NAGE) is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment, and other conditions of employment.
