
Pursuant to a Consent Election by and between the Town of Middletown (Police Department) and the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #21, the Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board held an election on August 7, 2017, by secret ballot of: All Uniformed Members of the Town of Middletown, (Police Department) excluding the Deputy Chief of Police and the Chief of Police.

On the basis of the election of said employees as aforesaid, the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #21 has been designated by a majority of said employees of the Town of Middletown (Police Department), as their bargaining representative.

The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board by virtue of and pursuant to the powers vested in said Board by 28-7-16, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, it is hereby:

CERTIFIED, that the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #21, has been designated and selected by a majority of: All Uniformed Members of the Town of Middletown, (Police Department) excluding the Deputy Chief of Police and the Chief of Police, as their sole representative for the purpose of collective bargaining and that pursuant to the provisions of 28-7-16 of the Act; that the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #21 is the exclusive bargaining representative of said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, hours of employment and other conditions of employment.
